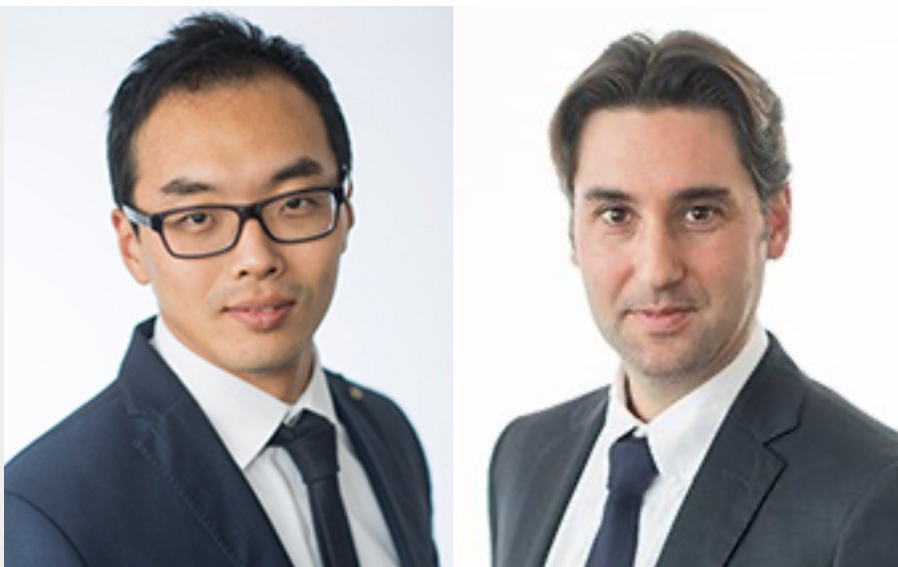


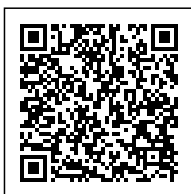
BAKER MCKENZIE HAS ADVISED WÜEST PARTNER IN HOMADATA ACQUISITION
