The company, whose A Shares are listed on Shenzhen Stock Exchange, expects to use the net proceeds from the offering to finance its global R&D initiatives and fund its overseas expansion. Credit Suisse, CLSA Limited and China International Capital Corporation (UK) acted as joint global coordinators on the transaction. Trading in the GDRs on SIX Swiss Exchange started on 21 September 2022.
