

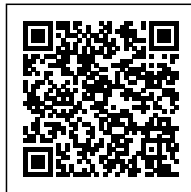
RE:CAP ACQUIRED THREE WIND FARMS: THE ADVISORS

Three wind farms to one buyer: the Swiss **re:cap global investors**, through its investment fund Fp Lux Investments, has acquired 19.2 megawatts (MW) wind projects located in Melgven, Callac and Gardelegen, from **Energiequelle**. In particular, the transaction includes acquisition of 8.4 MW Melgven, Callac wind farms in France and a 10.8 MW Gardelegen wind farm in Germany.
