The round is led by **Acton Capital Partners** from Munich, an international venture capital company that focuses on digital business models and sees strong revenue growth in Europe and North America. The new investment will go towards the provider's geographical expansion, growing the office in Karlsruhe and the German team. In addition, Skribble wants to advance into more European markets.
