
## WALDER WYSS ADVISES BOUYGUES ON THE SALE OF HELION TO AMAG

**Bouygues Energies & Services**, a Swiss renowed in the areas of building technology, facility management and energy supply technology to promote the energy transition, has announced the sale of its Helion business unit, which specializes in photovoltaics, heat pumps and e-mobility, to the **AMAG Group**. The transaction is expected to close in Q4 2022.

With Helion's acquisition, AMAG plans to contribute to the decarbonization of transport and to the security of supply in Switzerland with renewable energy. In addition, with the intelligent networking of e-cars and photovoltaics, AMAG and Helion want to provide a solution for using the electric car as a storage unit for better utilization of solar power and as a buffer storage unit for stabilizing the power grid.
