
WENGER VIELI ADVISES KONTRON ON THE SALE TO VINCI ENERGIES

Wenger Vieli toghether with Schoenherr Rechtsanwälte and Pinsent Masons has advised **Kontron** (formerly S&T) on the sale of significant parts of the IT services reading business to VINCI Energies. The transaction has been closed for a purchase price of approximately EUR 400 million.

The transaction was led by an international and cross-disciplinary team from Schoenherr Attorneys at Law alongside Pinsent Masons in Germany and the Wenger Vieli team in Switzerland.

Konton, a listed and growing IoT (Internet of Things) technology company, counts approximately 6'000 employees and subsidiaries in 32 countries around the world. With the divestment of significant parts of Kontron Group's IT services business, Kontron is following its growth strategy to becoming a pure IoT player and using its liquidity for further acquisitions.
